Teacher Tips:

***Build your child's autonomy** (I can do it myself) by encouraging him/her to dress themselves. Allowing your child to do things on their own allows them to become more independent, which builds their sense of pride, confidence and accomplishment. Even the little things matter!

***Talk it out** Encourage your child to talk about what they're doing. When children make their thought process verbal, it helps give adults insight into their thinking while also building the child's critical thinking skills and vocabulary.

Questions to encourage verbalization

While building with blocks, legs or drawing a picture-ask questions such as:
What are you making?

Tell me about this picture,
Tell me how you're building this,

Tell me why you chose that place, block, etc
